

Scott H. Birch is the Chief Investigator for the Idaho Attorney General and has been employed as an investigator with the Attorney General since December of 1990. In that capacity he has conducted investigations into crimes ranging from internal investigations for public agencies to homicide investigations and has served in the capacity of trial assistant in preparing trial exhibits and coordinating witnesses.

Scott began his law enforcement career in 1970 with the U.S. Army Military Police, since that time he has worked as a State Police trooper, fraud investigator, undercover narcotics investigator, as a Detective Lt. with a local police department and finally as an investigator with the Idaho Attorney General.

During his career Scott has investigated in excess of 100 homicides including cold cases. He has interviewed 1000s of victim's, witnesses and offenders.

Scott has extensive training and experience in crime scene investigation and analysis as well as interviews and interrogations.
